Haitian Earthquake Disaster Relief: what you can do:

Make checks payable to GRCC, noting "Haiti Earthquake Appeal". Your donations will be sent through the UCC One Great Hour of Sharing where the need is greatest. The most effective way we can assist right now with relief efforts is to make a cash contribution. Experienced disaster relief agencies prefer the flexibility of cash donations because they avoid the labor and expense of sorting, packing, transporting, and distributing donated items. Agencies can use cash to meet specific needs more quickly and money spent in disaster-impacted areas helps local economies to recover more quickly.
